## Hide N' Seek

To commemorate the Democratic National Convention, The Philadelphia 2016 Host Committee has placed decorative donkeys at various sites throughout the city. Through September 5, visit some of Philadelphia's top locations to see the 57 fiberglass donkeys, each representing one of the 50 states, one of the U.S. territories, Washington, D.C., or Democrats Abroad. Each donkey has designs created by 30 local artists, all with images depicting a certain state or territory (The Pennsylvania donkey features the wreath of the state flower, the Mountain laurel and the state bird, the Ruffle Grouse). The Host Committee has strategically placed them around Philly creating a road map to the best places to visit downtown and beyond (go to [artjawn.com](http://artjawn.com) for a full map). To help with your search, we highlight some of their homes below:

- **ONE LIBERTY OBSERVATION DECK:** A donkey with a view.
- **INDEPENDENCE BEER GARDEN:** Enjoy a beer with a donkey.
- **BETSY ROSS HOUSE:** Learn about the flag, donkey style.
- **THE KIMMEL CENTER:** The donkey makes for a nice pre-show attraction before the main performance.
- **PHILADELPHIA MUSEUM OF ART:** Enjoy the art in the exhibitions and the art on the PMA's donkey.
